

What is IAACE?

The Indiana Association for Adult and Continuing Education is a statewide association of individuals and institutions promoting the education and training of adults. The organization evolved from a group of adult educators who first met in December 1943 to discuss the future of adult education in Indiana. Since that time, many changes have occurred in Indiana's social and economic structure that resulted in increased need for adult education.

The association has changed along with the times. The current Indiana Association for Adult and Continuing Education was formed in 1983.

The purpose of IAACE is to provide leadership for the advancement of the education of adults in the lifelong learning process. We advocate for the field of adult and continuing education. We provide staff development. We encourage and implement research. And, we communicate in various ways with the membership and the public.

IAACE has two commissions which are units that exist to perform specific functions.



The Commission for Adult Basic and Secondary Education

This is the unit that will lobby to influence and encourage legislation and policy benefiting you and your adult students. The commission holds a 501(c)4 tax status.



The Commission for Literacy

The organization formerly known as the Indiana Adult Literacy Coalition joined IAACE as a commission in the summer of 2007. This unit will continue to serve local literacy coalitions throughout Indiana.
